required to track and report attendance,

especially persistent absenteeism

(missing 10% or more of sessions), to

local authorities and the Department for

Education (DfE).The DfE emphasises that

attendance is closely linked to pupil safety,

academic progress, and future life chances.

Regular attendance supports strong outcomes,

while frequent absence can be an early indicator

that a child may need additional support. It is

also linked to lower attainment and reduced

future opportunities if not addressed early.

Every day at school counts. Even a small

number of missed days can have a noticeable

impact on a child's education. We share this

information to help families understand why we

may contact you regarding attendance and why

a collaborative approach between home and

school is so important.

Breakfast and After School Club

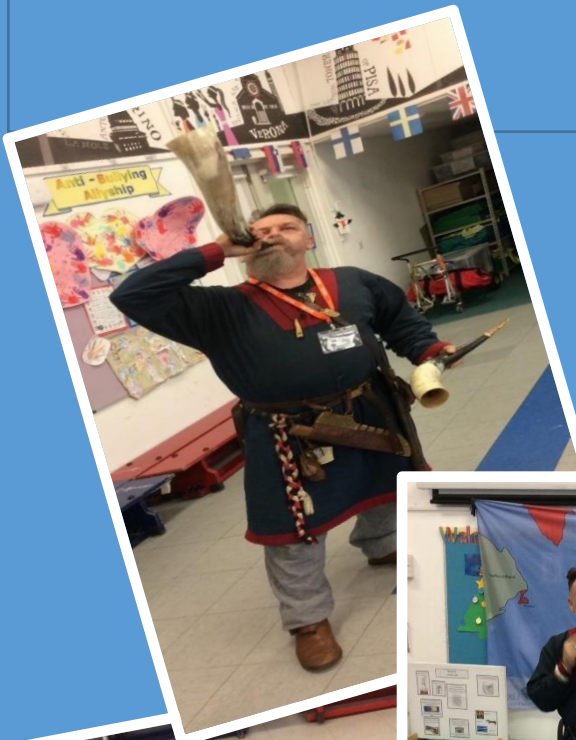
Do you need affordable,

after school.

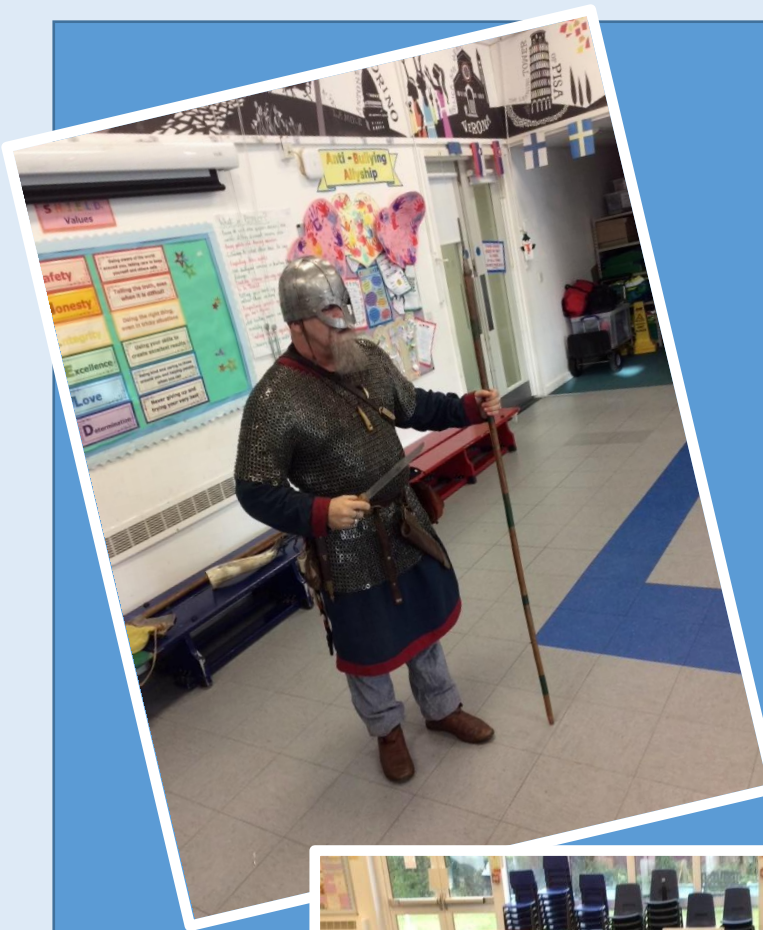
